Northland School Division utilizes Zoom for professional learning with staff and to support student learning.

Board of Trustees discussed important issues with local MLAs

The Board of Trustees kicked off the Regular Board Meeting via Zoom having a conversation with Tany Yao, MLA for Fort McMurray-Wood Buffalo and David Hanson, MLA for Bonnyville-Cold Lake-St. Paul. The trustees spoke to the MLAs about the division's lunch program, recruitment and retention of staff and funding for staff housing. The constituencies for Yao and Hanson are located within NSD boundaries. The Board appreciated the opportunity to discuss important issues impacting NSD and look forward to having future dialogue.

2020-2021 School Year Calendar Approved

The Board of Trustees approved the Northland School Division 2020-2021 School Year Calendar. The calendar is geared towards accommodating families. A winter break is scheduled during the second week of February (February 8-12, 2021). Principals and teachers will be attending Teachers Convention during that time. Spring break is scheduled March 29 - April 5, 2021. The division's intention is to align with Native Hockey Provincials. A number of NSD students participate in the annual hockey tournament. Orientation for new staff will look different. New teachers will participate in orientation located in their school communities instead of in a central location. Superintendent Highlights - Developing Continuing Student Learning Plan

Superintendent of Schools Dr. Nancy Spencer-Poitras updated the Board on what's been happening in Northland since the Government of Alberta, Alberta Health Services and Alberta Education cancelled all K-12 classes indefinitely due to Covid-19 (coronavirus). Since the announcement, Spencer-Poitras said the division has been working on a continuing student learning plan. This work includes creating alternative programming through the use of technology. If a family or a community does not have access to technology, alternative programming will be arranged. The division's continuing student learning plan will be communicated to students, parents and community members before March 30th.
