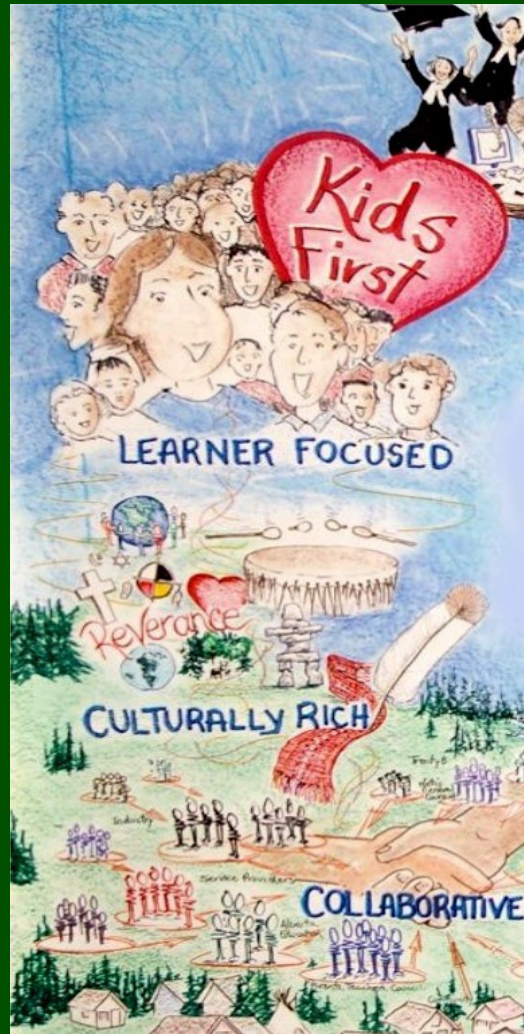

### **Success for every student**

Student attendance improvement; focus on literacy for English, Cree and Dené; land-based learning; complete community resource list for all NSD communities and move forward with regional/virtual high school project.

### **Quality teacher and school leadership**

Develop indicators for quality teaching; improve student assessment standards, report card process and access to student data for parents and design and implement a strategy for teacher housing.

### **Engage and effective governance**

Complete revisions to Policy Manual and formalize a school review process.

- Schools follow division-wide literacy plan to help students succeed and encourage support from parents and community members.
- Number of students reading at grade level in grades 1-8 has increased by 19% since 2013!

## Celebrating Success

### Attendance Improvement Initiative 'Every Day Counts'

- 44% of our students attended 90% or better in 2014-2015.
- 2% attendance improvement division-wide (82%)
