Fort Chipewyan Inside Door Project 2016

Scope of work:

The work includes removing the two sets of doors at the end of the connector corridor that houses the library and building a 2x6 stud wall to the required rough opening dimensions.

Doors are being replaced through another contract.

The work will include providing all the material, equipment and labor required to complete this job. The rough opening must be finished after the doors are installed in keeping with the surrounding walls and will include trims and base complementary to the existing school decoration scheme. Fire rated sheeting to be used in keeping with the fire rating requirements.

Wall is to be taped and plastered in keeping with common finishing practices and techniques. Prime and paint as per accepted practices, and in any event two finishing coats will be applied.

Any floor patch up work will also be included in this work. Care to be taken to match the tiles as closely as possible to the existing décor.

The doors that are removed will have all hardware stripped off as well as the safety glass taken out and saved for use at another time should the need arise. The hardware bundles will be kept separate and all matching pieces properly separated labelled as to the door location where it was removed. A Northlands representative will direct as to a proper storage location.

The work is to substantively completed (rough stud opening framed up, gyproc installed) by August 14th., and the remaining of the finishing can be completed after the doors are installed. (at present – this time frame is scheduled for the following week)

It is also a condition of the contract that a photo log be kept of the progress of the job, with before and after pictures submitted with final invoice, but available throughout the project to a



Northland employee for viewing. Pictures taken should be of sufficient quantity to demonstrate the various major steps in the contract.

The rough openings sizes are attached as an appendix.

Bidders will also include their regular hourly labor rate should there be additional work required not envisaged at the time of bidding and not included in this scope of work.

Potential bidders should be aware and be compliant with all applicable building codes, rules and regulations regarding safety, protection of the environment and be in good standing with the Workers Compensation requirements. Please include your WCB certificate with your bid.
